

Hello Church Leaders,

I have a rare opportunity that I would like to pass on to you for your consideration. As you are likely aware, within the Fire and Emergency Services Community we daily deal with Critical Incident Stress because our staff see, hear and smell things that most of humanity never does. As such, we invest a lot of time and energy in defusing and debriefing our staff after incidents to help them deal with and process this. We have a special team within the service to take the lead on this and these members are trained through the Critical Incident Stress Foundation (ICISF).

A number of years ago I met a great ICISF instructor by the name of Jim Nelms. In addition to extensive emergency services experience, Jim is also an ordained pastor and as a result also teaches a certified, 2 day, Pastoral Crisis Intervention course.

Jim is teaching courses to our, and surrounding area, departments this week. On May 5 and 6 he will be teaching the Pastor Crisis Intervention Course. As we have several spots available I would like to open it up to all church leaders (Pastors and people involved in immediate church leadership eg: Consistories etc).

I think you will find the content invaluable as you commonly deal with crisis situations in families and many have had no formal training in this subject. If you are interested please read through the program content in the link below. Also please pass this on to whomever may have interest. It is however important that we keep registrations to people directly involved in church leadership (otherwise the group will get too varied).

The course will take place at the Galt Museum. Course registration cost has been kept at "cost recovery" to ensure it's affordable.
