Bible League Canada is delighted to continue being one of the accredited nondenominational organizations with the Christian Reformed Church in North America. Being reviewed and approved by the annual synod builds our relationship and

affirms our common mission to see lives transformed by the Living Word of God!

Established in 1960 by John & Jo Vanderboom, Bible League Canada has a long history of Scripture placement in Canada and internationally. Rev. John G. Klomps, director in 1985, continued to expand and grow the ministry and was instrumental in the establishment of the Bibles for Mission Thrift Stores (see story page 2). 1997 saw Rev. David Tigchelaar as executive director, followed by Mr. Dick Kranendonk in 2006. Today, under the leadership of Dr. Paul Richardson, Bible League Canada continues the commitment to doing missions through extraordinary international partnerships in over 40 countries.

What can YOU do?

Dear Friends,

Jesus' command in Matthew 28:19 is clear: "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit..." (NIV)

As you strive to carry out the great commission, let Bible League Canada be your hands and feet for missions. Your primary mission goal, to bring Jesus to your community, is the same as the local champions we partner with in their communities, but they need your support.

Local champions are waiting for Bibles and training. These volunteer teachers, leaders, and pastors are eager for the training that equips them to fulfill their calling to disciple children and adults in their neighbourhoods. Will you provide the Bibles and training?

- To support the training for 1 local champion to start 1-2 churches during their 2 years of hands-on training is just \$2,300.
- Training a volunteer teacher to teach a 30-person adult Bible-based literacy class is just \$1,350.
- Equipping volunteer leader with Bibles and the necessary training for children's Bible Clubs and Camps is just \$20 per child.
- Carefully providing Bibles to persecuted Christians in countries where it is dangerous to be a Christian, is just \$5 a Bible.
